

Position: Lead Mechanic

Description:

To plan and lead the work of aircraft mechanics. The lead mechanic should be skilled in performing inspections and repairs on a variety of aircraft in order to provide supervision for the mechanics assigned to assist in completion of projects.

Responsibilities:

- Must be able to obtain and maintain an Airport Security Badge through Houston Hobby Airport.
- Leads scheduled maintenance of various lengths from light inspections to heavy maintenance inspections on a wide variety of airframes.
- Responsible for guiding, instructing and scheduling the work of three or more team members and provides job related training or instruction as required.
- Performs and oversees work on aircraft systems, including but not limited to landing gear systems, air conditioner systems, pressurization systems, hydraulic, pneumatic, optional equipment installations, minor interior repairs and touch-up type paint work.
- Provides clear, concise and accurate written documentation of work performed to include inspection progress, parts identification and return to service documents.
- May be required to observe operation of mechanical systems during flight and troubleshoot problems for in-shop repairs.

- 5+ years of experience in Corporate Aviation Maintenance
- Owns a basic set of hand tools with the ability to demonstrate inventory and control of tools
- Demonstrates proficient Time Management Skills
- Willing to work in a team-based atmosphere

- Experience in troubleshooting
- Willing to work overtime for AOG jobs as necessary
